As the Arcadia Farm Field Trip contact person for my school, I will assure that:

- The Note to Families and Student Medical and Media Release Forms are sent home with students for parents/guardians to sign and return. Each student must have a signed form to participate. Please bring them with you on your field trip.
- The *Adult Medical and Media Release Forms* are sent home for each chaperone to sign and return. Remember, no more than 9 adults can come on the trip, including teachers. Bring these forms with you.
- Each student completes the *Field Trip Pre-test*. This will help us gauge whether learning objectives are met during the field trip. Bring the completed tests with you on your field trip.
- I will bring a check for the full amount field trip fee minus the deposit (\$50) made out to "Arcadia Center for Sustainable Food & Agriculture."
- All participants will dress accordingly. The entire trip is outdoors and involves hands-on, gardenbased activities.
- All students bring bagged lunches either from home, or from your school's food service provider. A
 Salad Bar at lunch, water, and simple picnic facilities will be provided.
- I will take an active role in supervising students, so that we can have a productive and enjoyable visit to the farm.



- I will fill out the online *Teacher Evaluation* that will be provided in a follow-up email after the trip. Upon completion of the survey, teachers will be entered in a raffle for a restaurant gift card at the end of the season!
- Students complete the *Field Trip Post-Test* within 1 week of your trip. Return the evaluations to us in the stamped envelope provided. We will follow up if we have not received your tests within 2 weeks.

By signing this contract, you also confirm that you understand the following policies:

Field Trip Deposit

In order to prevent last minute field trip cancellations we require participating schools to mail in a deposit as part of registering for a field trip. Schools are required to mail a check for \$50, which will be deposited upon receipt and applied towards the full cost of the field trip. A school's field trip will not be confirmed until their deposit has been received in the form of a check made out to "Arcadia Center for Sustainable Food & Agriculture" or via PayPal with this signed contract.

Field Trip Fees

In order to maintain our facilities and skilled staff, we charge small fees for each field trip group. Field trip fees are calculated according to the percentage of students eligible for Free or Reduced Price (FRP) meals at each participating school.

Payment is due in *full* on the date of the field trip and can be paid using a credit card. If late, the cost increases \$5 per day.

School Cancellation Policy

If a school must cancel a scheduled field trip, the school must contact Farm Education Manager Ivy (ivy@arcadiafood.org) **immediately**. If the school cancels the field trip before two weeks prior to the scheduled date of the trip, the \$50 deposit will be returned in full. If the school cancels the field trip during the two weeks prior to the scheduled date, the deposit will not be returned. Schools that cancel field trips during the two weeks prior to their scheduled date will not be eligible for rescheduling their field trip.

Weather Cancellation Policy

In the case of extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to snow, very cold temperatures, thunderstorms, and heavy rain) Arcadia Farm may cancel the field trip. Cancellations due to weather conditions will be made before the end of school on the day before the scheduled trip. Arcadia staff will contact the school in the event of inclement weather via phone or email on the day prior to their scheduled field trip. If the trip is cancelled due to inclement weather, schools will be given the opportunity to reschedule, if possible, or the deposit will be returned in full.

I understand the above policies and expectations, and I am committed to complying with them so that we have a great field trip!
